What resources are needed to implement the program? Examples: staff, funding, equipment.	What will the program do? Examples: training, workshops, services.	What tangible deliverables or products will result? Examples: number of sessions, participants served.	What immediate changes will occur as a result? Examples: increased knowledge, skills, or awareness.	What changes will occur over time? Examples: behavior changes, improved practices.	What are the ultimate changes or impacts the program aims to achieve? Examples: societal benefits, systemic improvements.

Instructions for Use

1. Inputs: List the resources required to implement the program (e.g., funding, personnel, facilities).
2. Activities: Identify the main tasks or processes the program will undertake.
3. Outputs: Specify the direct results or deliverables of the activities.
4. Short-Term Outcomes: Focus on immediate benefits (e.g., learning outcomes).
5. Intermediate Outcomes: Include medium-term effects (e.g., behavior or practice changes).
6. Long-Term Outcomes: Highlight the broader impacts or end goals of the program.
